



Part 1: What Sort of Lies Does Satan Tell?

LARGE GROUP ACTIVITY

Satan lies to us in many ways. Today we will review some of the lies he tells that keep us poor.

Go through each of the Lie Cards.

Facilitator Instructions: Lay all the Lie Cards on the floor (or put them on the wall). Make sure the class understands the lies. Don't discuss the truths yet. Now ask the class to put a marker (leaves, beans, toothpicks, pebbles...or mark the paper with a pen) on each of the lies that are common in their community.

Some people are better than other people. We are not important.	
The gospel message only affects our spiritual life.	

• Can you think of 2 more common lies that Satan tells us? (Write them on the 2 blank cards.)

SMALL GROUP ACTIVITY

Facilitator Instructions: Break the class into groups of 3-4. Give each group 1-2 lie cards and tell them the verses listed on the truth side of the table. Give them a few minutes to look up the verses and talk about what God's truth is for that lie.
